International Students

Are you currently in Australia?

You <u>must</u> attend F2F classes from Monday 14 February. If you do not attend, you will be breaking your Student Visa conditions and your enrolment may be cancelled.

From 14 February 2022, anyone attending UQ campuses, sites or facilities <u>must</u> be fully vaccinated – with an approved TGA vaccine – against COVID-19. You should have **received an email** requesting a declaration of your vaccination status via a secure online UQ portal. The declaration should be completed as soon as possible. Please contact Student Services <u>support@uqcollege.uq.edu.au</u> if you have not received this email.

Are you still in your home country and want to continue studying online?

Online classes will continue to run for those students who wish to remain in their home country. Keep attending your online classes as per usual.

For those wishing to come to Australia as soon as possible please contact your Agent.

If you have already booked a flight to Australia, contact admissions@uqcollege.uq.edu.au to inform UQ College of your arrival date.

Where possible, you should plan to arrive in Australia as close to the start of a new teaching session. Upcoming session start dates are as follows:

Session 4: 26 April

For entry into Queensland, you are required to:

- Be fully vaccinated with a completed dosage of a vaccine approved or recognised by Australia's Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA)
- Hold a valid visa
- Provide proof of your vaccination status
- Take a COVID-19 test within 24 hours of arriving

Online classes will continue to run for those students who wish to continue in this mode.

If you wish to complete your course in face-to-face mode, you will need to be fully vaccinated - with an approved TGA vaccine — against COVID-19.
