Entry Requirements

- Completion of High School Year 11 in Australia, or competencies that demonstrate equivalence at a comparable level.
- Mature-age students or learners from disadvantaged groups without the minimum educational requirements for entry, who are able to demonstrate through interview/testimonials/work samples, the maturity and motivation to succeed in the course may be granted special entry.
- Successful completion of a subject specific Language, Literacy and Numeracy test.
- Students seeking entry into Biology, Chemistry or Physics are required to have undertaken at least one year of science in their senior high school studies.
- Students seeking entry into Mathematical Methods are required to have undertaken at least one year of a maths subject in their senior high school studies.
- Students may only enrol in one course at a time.
