

Certificate IV in Adult Tertiary Preparation - 11240NAT

The following information is provided to assist domestic students who have completed (or are currently undertaking) the Queensland Certificate IV in Adult Tertiary Preparation (CATP), and intend to seek admission to undergraduate study at The University of Queensland (UQ).

The CATP is recognised as a Year 12 alternative and is ideal for students needing an online study option or for adults who have not participated in formal study for some time.

To attain the full qualification, you will need to complete three English units you need to select another two or three course areas comprising six units from General Mathematics, Pure Mathematics (equivalent to Mathematical Methods), Chemistry, Biology, or Psychology.

Delivery

You'll have synchronous evening classes and consultation sessions via Zoom with our highly qualified teachers. Classes take place Monday to Thursday from 7 to 9pm and you'll need to commit around five hours per unit, per week over three terms (10 weeks per term).

If you take Biology or Chemistry units, you'll also be required to attend face-to-face laboratory sessions at our St Lucia campus and one field trip to Nudgee Beach in Brisbane (Biology only). For completion of the Biology or Chemistry units, attendance at these activities is compulsory and non-negotiable.

How to apply

To apply you will need:

- Unique Student Identifier
- Be an Australian or New Zealand Citizen or hold a permanent visa
- Be at least 18 years old or turning 18 within the enrolment period

Satisfying subject prerequisites

The successful completion (i.e. minimum grade of pass, JP or J1) of the following CATP subjects (which may comprise of 2 or 3 elective units for subjects completed since 2008) will meet the listed subject prerequisites for entry to all undergraduate programs at UQ.

Gaining a selection rank

UQ does not accept a partially completed CATP for the allocation of a selection rank. To be eligible to receive a selection rank, applicants must complete the entire CATP program. However, subjects from a partially completed CATP may be used for the purpose of meeting subject prerequisites.

For CATP studies undertaken from 2008 - 2013, students were required to complete at least 10 modules including the subject Language and Learning in order to be awarded

the Queensland CATP. Selection ranks are derived from the best 10 modules attempted. From 2014, 9 elective units are required for completion.

A selection rank may be solely assigned to the grade average of the elective units completed, or combined with a result from the Special Tertiary Admissions Test.

NOTE: Ranks will not be assigned from this study if you have completed the equivalent of one full time year (or more) of tertiary level study.

- To be awarded Certificate IV in Adult Tertiary Preparation, students must successfully complete 9 units (3 core and 6 electives). Specialisations may be comprised of 2 or 3 elective units of equal weighting. The core unit Plan and Prepare for Study is not included for assessment on this schedule.
- Where: H=6.5, J3=6.5, JH=6.5, C=5, J2=5, JC=5, P=4, J1=4, JP=4, R=1.5, M=1.5, N=1.5 and M1=0.
- Where elective unit weightings are provided, these will be used in the calculation of a GPA. Where elective unit weightings are not provided, all elective units will be assumed to have equal weighting.
- Where an applicant has studied more than 9 units, only the best 8 award eligible units will be used in the derivation of a rank. Where the same elective unit has been completed on more than one occasion, only one attempt will be considered in the calculation of a rank, and this shall be the best result achieved.

Please note: Prior to 2008, students were required to complete five subjects, including the subject Language and Learning Skills, in order to be awarded the Queensland CATP. Selection ranks for completed pre-2008 CATP studies are calculated from the grade average in 5 subjects (including the subject Language and Learning Skills).
