Face to Face

Bridging Program

Commence at UQ Semester 1, 2026

Experience studying at the St Lucia campus. This is an intensive short course taking place over four weeks. Successful completion of an individual course will satisfy the prerequisite requirements for The University of Queensland in:

- o Mathematical Methods,
- o Physics,
- o Chemistry, or
- o Biology

Commence at UQ Semester 1, 2026

Delivered online, you'll have the support you need to reach your goals. As a self-directed program, completion time will vary from student to student. Students investing 15 hours per week in their course can expect to complete the program within 10 weeks.
