



The Award

This scholarship is intended to support students from either a low Socio-Economic Status (SES) or Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander background.

A 50% scholarship will be offered to 15 students who study either Pure Mathematics (Mathematical Methods) or General Mathematics.

The scholarship provides reduced fees as follows:

Pure Mathematics: \$990 → **\$445**
General Mathematics: \$660 → **\$330**



Eligibility

You must meet the following criteria to be eligible:

- Be an Australian Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Indicate in your application for the Online Bridging Course that you would like to apply for the scholarship.
- Meet one of the following conditions
 - Be from an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander background
 - Be from a Low Socio-Economic background



Application Process

1. Begin your application for the Online Bridging Course.
2. During the application form, indicate that you would like to apply for the scholarship, and which criteria you meet.
3. Upload documentation that proves you meet this criteria.
 - a. For Low SES Scholarship – Your financial circumstances (Centrelink statement, tax notice, etc.)
 - b. For Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Scholarship – Proof of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander status

If successful, you will be notified that you have received the scholarship once your application has been processed. You must accept their scholarship within 2 weeks upon receiving this confirmation.
