Pure Mathematics (Mathematical Methods)

This course is the equivalent of Mathematical Methods for prerequisite purposes.

This course suits students who need to meet the entry requirements for programs such as Biomedical Science, Commerce, Information Technology, Engineering and Science.

Course dates and fees

As this program is self-delivered, the length of study will vary from student to student.

As a general guide, students investing 3 - 5 hours per week in the course can expect to complete;

- Pure Mathematics in approximately 30 weeks
- General Mathematics in approximately 20 weeks

You will have up to 1 year from your commencement date to complete the course. Commencement dates occur on the 2nd and 4th Monday of each month.

How to apply for offshore international students

In order to apply, you must:

- Have an IELTS of 5.5 (no band <5) or equivalent
- Be at least 17 years old
- Have successfully completed Mathematics at a minimum Australian Year 10 level
- NOT be living in Australia
