- Demonstrated knowledge, skills, and experience in educational technology and eLearning.
- Clear evidence of interest and involvement in professional development activities.

- Team player with strong interpersonal and communication skills and demonstrated ability to work collaboratively and flexibly with all colleagues across the college.
