This bursary is open to Chinese students who are studying Bridging English + a UQ postgraduate program. If you accept your packaged offer 12 weeks before your BE class start date, you will receive an **exclusive 20% reduction on BE tuition fees*** — a valuable opportunity to strengthen your English skills and start your studies with confidence.

Study Bridging English instead of retaking your English test

Bridging English will empower you to:

- Follow lectures confidently with enhanced academic listening skills in large classes, tutorials or everyday interactions.
- Actively participate in group discussions, express your ideas clearly and collaborate effectively at a postgraduate level.
- Deliver professional, engaging presentations that leave a strong impression on peers and teaching staff.
- Approach challenging academic readings strategically, improving both your efficiency and understanding.
- Produce well-structured, high-quality academic writing that meets UQ's expectations and standards.
- Master core academic skills, including paraphrasing, summarising, synthesising, and referencing — skills essential from your very first day.
- Develop valuable transferable skills such as leadership, critical thinking, communication, and self management, strengthening your academic performance and enhancing your competitiveness in the global job market.

Bursary conditions

- **Accept early to save 20%** — you must accept your Bridging English + UQ Postgraduate packaged conditional offer within 12 weeks of your BE course start date to receive the bursary.
- **Don't miss the deadline** — if you don't accept your offer within 12 weeks of your BE course start date, the bursary will be cancelled. Standard tuition fees will then apply, and you will receive a new offer at the standard fee rate.
- Deferrals depend on whether you submitted an English test
 - If you submitted an English Proficiency test with your original application, deferral is not permitted.
 - If you did not submit an English test, a deferral may be considered.
- **Start your postgraduate program on time.** You must commence your UQ postgraduate program in Semester 1, 2027 or Semester 2, 2027 to remain eligible.
